SUBJECT: MovingAhead – Community, Neighborhood and Environmental Justice Technical Report - Census Data Update for Coburg Road Enhanced Corridor and Coburg Road EmX Corridor

DATE: March 9, 2018

The MovingAhead project’s Community, Neighborhood and Environmental Justice Technical Report (July 17, 2017) presented census block group data for the Coburg Road Corridor up to the west side of Interstate 5 (I-5). Census block group data has been queried for the Coburg Road Enhanced Corridor (1/4-mile buffer) and the Coburg Road EmX Corridor (1/2-mile buffer), which extends from Eugene to Gateway Station, east of I-5. Totals and percentages have been calculated for this area. The purpose of this memorandum is to provide the totals and percentages for insertion into the Community, Neighborhood and Environmental Justice Technical Report tables in Section S.1.4 and in Section 5.3.

One additional item of note:

- Table S.1-2: Currently the heading for the low-income data point in this table reads “Population for Whom Poverty Determined.” We recommend changing this heading to read “Low-Income Population (percent)” to be consistent with the heading in table 5.3-5.
